





The State of Minnesota partners with GovRAMP

The State of Minnesota is a participating government in <u>GovRAMP</u>, reinforcing its commitment to strengthening digital infrastructure and safeguarding sensitive information. As part of this initiative, all contracts involving cloud and hosted service providers that handle high-categorized data—defined by the State—will require a verified GovRAMP status.

All cloud-based vendors handling high-categorized data—both new and existing—must be GovRAMP Authorized by **April 1, 2027**.

- Note: The state will recognize a vendor's FedRAMP Authorization in lieu of separate GovRAMP
 Authorization. However, the vendor must enroll in GovRAMP's continuous monitoring program to
 provide the state with access to ongoing security reports and audit data. This is necessary because
 FedRAMP continuous monitoring materials are available only to federal entities and not accessible
 to state agencies.
